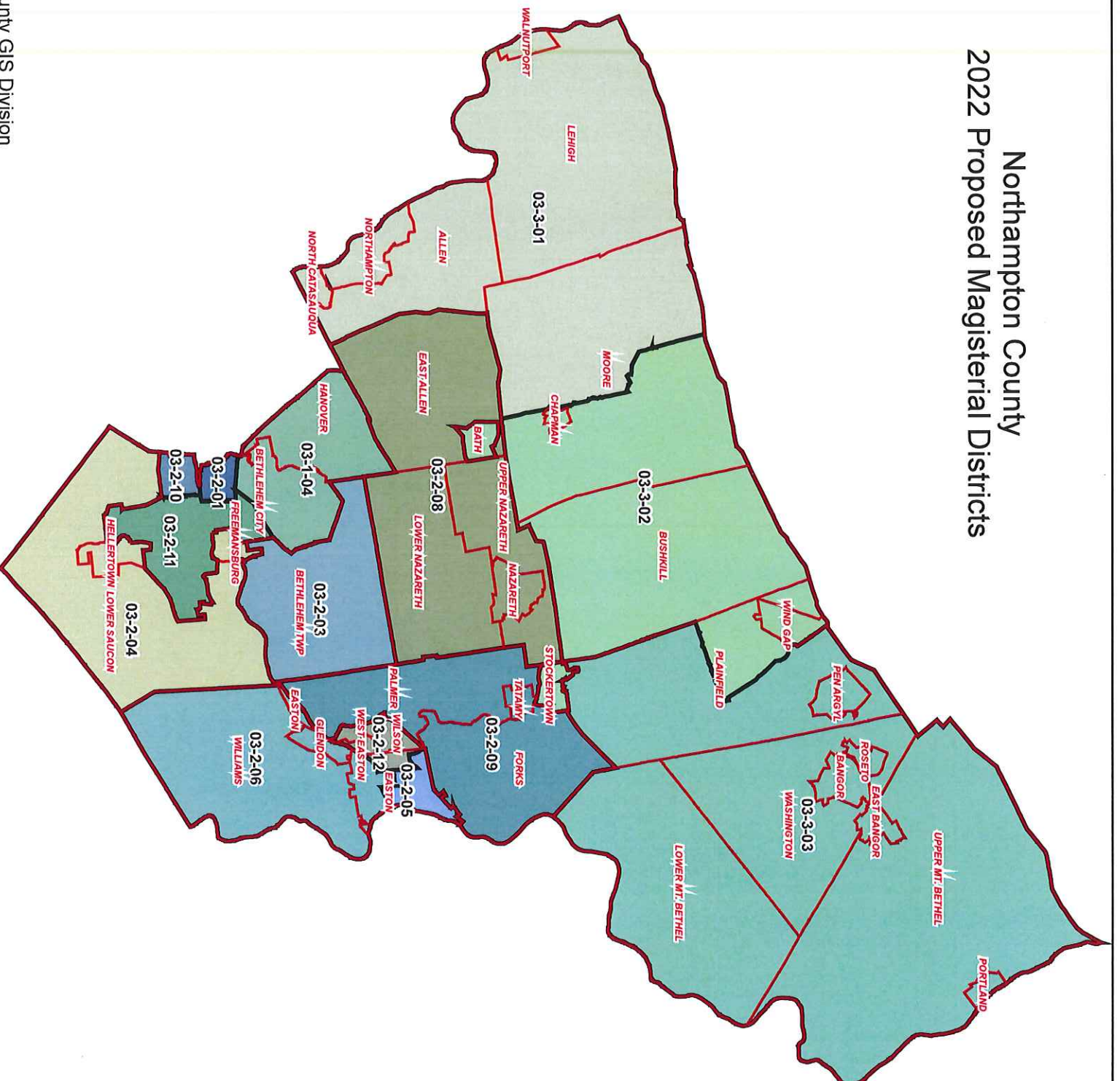


Proposed Magisterial Redistricting Plan for the Third Judicial District
